Housing

On-campus dormitories available include the CJ International House and Anam Hall 2. The CJ International House is an air conditioned, suite-style facility for 258 men and women. It offers singles and doubles and has semi-private baths. Bathroom facilities are connected to the suite. Anam Hall 2 is an air conditioned, coed dorm for 84 students. It offers triples and is a traditional corridor-style residence facility.
