Nanyang Technological University (NTU) was ranked 50th globally and 7th in Asia by The Times Higher Education Supplement in a 2004 ranking of the world's best universities. NTU has a top-tier business school with one of the top 100 MBA programs in the world. The university was established in 1955. NTU opens its doors to students in engineering and business, biological and physical sciences, as well as humanities, journalism and the arts. Almost 50% of NTU's graduate students and 20% of all undergraduates are international students. Students and faculty enjoy a rich academic curriculum, offered in collaboration with partner universities in America, Asia, and Europe. Internships are available, but not guaranteed, for students who would like to remain in Singapore for the summer. The internships generally last for 3 months.

The Nanyang exchange was arranged through a special agreement with the Department of Accountancy at the University of Illinois, and is the only program where accountancy students can have accountancy courses transfer. Business students from other majors cannot take accountancy courses at Nanyang.
